- Perth and Kinross 76 primary schools.
- All were examined using various factors in 2010.
- September 2009 census less than 15 pupils.
- Highest projected roll less than 15 pupils.
- Occupancy less than 40%.

Review of Catchment Area










 Site is currently split between Logiealmond and Methyen catchment areas.




 Operational arrangements affecting Glenalmond College staff and their children.
