The **Perth Shopmobility** Scheme can be found in the Canal Street Car park, which is entered from Canal Street by car. (Parking is free to all Blue Badge holders)

Note - Pedestrians can gain access to the car park via Ropemakers Close, a walkway joining Canal Street to South Street.

If your answer is **YES**, then why not use Shopmobility!

WHAT IS SHOPMOBILITY?

Shopmobility is a scheme to lend, free of charge, manual wheelchairs and powered scooters. A companion service for people requiring assistance whilst shopping is also available. This helps people who have limited mobility or visual impairment to shop and use other town centre facilities.

WHO CAN USE IT?

Shopmobility is open to anyone, who feels that getting around the Perth shopping areas is difficult.

You **DO NOT** have to be registered as having a disability to use the service.



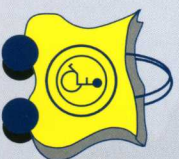
DO I HAVE TO BOOK?

This is recommended. A quick telephone call to Shopmobility ensures that equipment is available.

1. Powered scooters and manual wheelchairs can be booked by telephoning **01738 783960**
2. Training on the use of equipment may also be booked.
3. A volunteer companion can also be made available (but advance notice will be required)

IS THERE A CHARGE?

Shopmobility facilities are available absolutely **FREE**. A donation box will be on hand if you would like to help with the running costs. Charges apply to overnight and short term hires.
