
Lower Birks of Aberfeldy – short walk from Bridgend near the square in Aberfeldy through the Memorial Arch. The path is well compacted and gently sloping upwards from the arch. Nearest disabled toilets are in the Locus Centre in the square and at Breadalbane Community Campus.












PKC Adopted Core Paths








The bridge over the Moness Burn is wide and suitable for all user groups, a viewpoint of the burn is reached before the bridge over the lade (250m from arch). Over the bridge steep steps lead up to the Crieff Road and the Upper Birks.







The viewpoint features an engraved stone as well as views of the burn. Watch out for dippers bobbing on the stones in the burn !







After crossing the bridge over the lade, steep steps link to Crieff Road and the car park and tree trail of the Upper Birks. Traffic lights help a safe road crossing.
