2013/14 FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Joint Report by Head of Finance & Executive Director (Environment)

PURPOSE OF REPORT

This report details the Income and Expenditure to 6 November 2013 and the projected outturn to 31 March 2014.

1. BACKGROUND / MAIN ISSUES

1.1 The Committee approved the budget at the meeting of 1 May 2013. This report provides the monitoring position and projected outturn for the Financial Year 2013/2014.

2. PROPOSALS

2.1 Financial Statement 2013/14

On the basis of Appendix 1, it is anticipated that a deficit of £1,082 will accrue in 2013/14 and that the Fund's estimated Revenue Account Balance will be £1,357,818 at 31 March 2014. The main movements are additional expenditure of £15,000 in relation to the works to be undertaken for the improvements to the Moncrieffe Island Causeway as reported to this Committee at the meeting on 2 October 2013, (Report No 13/469 refers) and the reduction of Commercial Rent Income as detailed within section 2.2.

2.2 Common Good Status of the Operational Harbour Area

Counsel's Opinion is that not all Council-owned land lying within the operational harbour area should be classified as Common Good. Perth Common Good have been in receipt of Commercial Rent Income for a proportion of this area which was previously treated as Common Good but which will cease with effect from 1 April 2013 as it has now been determined that the land is not Common Good. The projected outturn for Commercial Rent Income has been reduced by £18,800 to reflect the reduction in income. This reduction is offset against a projected increase of £9,000 as reported to this Committee at the meeting on 2 October 2013, (Report No 13/469 refers).

3. CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

3.1 The Committee is requested to note the Perth Common Good Fund Income and Expenditure to 6 November 2013 and the projected outturn to 31 March 2014.
