What support can the EYIS provide?

- Home visiting to work with the child and offer advice to parents to support their child's learning.
- Assessment and planning.
- Attendance at relevant meetings.
- Collaboration with nursery staff to support the child in mainstream nursery.
- Specific training to Early Years staff.
- Collaborative working with other professionals.
- Supporting transition to school.

Who provides this service?

Teachers with knowledge and experience in:

- working with parents/carers and children in their home;
- *early child development;*
- Additional Support Needs;
- working with other supportive services.



Who can request support from the EYIS?

Requests can come from a range of sources:

- parents
- health visitors/GPs
- Allied Health professionals
- pre-school staff
- social workers

- voluntary agencies

Requests can only be made with parental permission
