What support can the EYIS provide?

- *Home visiting - to work with the child and offer advice to parents to support their child's learning.*
- *Assessment and planning.*
- *Attendance at relevant meetings.*
- *Collaboration with nursery staff to support the child in mainstream nursery.*
- *Specific training to Early Years staff.*
- *Collaborative working with other professionals.*
- *Supporting transition to school.*

Who provides this service?

Teachers with knowledge and experience in:

- *working with parents/carers and children in their home;*
- *early child development;*
- *Additional Support Needs;*
- *working with other supportive services.*

Who can request support from the EYIS?

Requests can come from a range of sources:

- *parents*
- *health visitors/GPs*
- *Allied Health professionals*
- *pre-school staff*
- *social workers*
- *educational psychologists*
- *paediatrician*
- *voluntary agencies*

Requests can only be made with parental permission

The Service aims to:

- *assist in identifying children's needs;*
- *promote child development through planned activities;*
- *support parents as the main educators of their child;*
- *provide an opportunity for parents to discuss their concerns fully;*
- *work co-operatively with fellow professionals out with education;*
- *consult with and work co-operatively alongside staff in pre-school provision;*
- *assist parents in finding information to support their choice of nursery or school.*
