2014/15 FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Joint Report by Head of Finance & Executive Director (Environment)

PURPOSE OF REPORT

This report details the Income and Expenditure to 19 November 2014 and the projected outturn to 31 March 2015 for the Perth Common Good Fund.

1. BACKGROUND / MAIN ISSUES

- 1.1 The Committee approved the budget at the meeting of 7 May 2014. This report provides the monitoring position and projected outturn for the Financial Year 2014/2015.

2. PROPOSALS

2.1 Financial Statement 2014/15

On the basis of Appendix 1, it is anticipated that there will be deficit of £78,700 in 2014/15 as a result of the upgrade works at Moncreiffe Island previously approved by this Committee, and that the Fund's estimated Revenue Account Balance will be £1,313,259 at 31 March 2015. The movement from the projected closing balance of £1,323,259 reported to this Committee on 8 October 2014 (report 14/419 refers) is attributed to the additional contribution towards the Perth Winter Festival event approved by this Committee on 8 October 2014 (report 14/418 refers).

3. CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 The Committee is requested to note the Perth Common Good Fund Income and Expenditure to 19 November 2014 and the projected outturn to 31 March 2015.
