Mitigation:


Exploration of additional carer support workers in each locality to enhance identification of hidden carers and linking carers to services, amenities and support within their local communities.

Justification:

Through various actions contained within the strategy's saction plan, this will support carers to access appropriate services, advice, information and support which is local to their communities and which will enable them to continue in their caring role.

3.2 Community Safety

The initiative will contribute towards reducing crime, disorder and danger and support social cohesiveness?



Mitigation:

This can be achieved through the promotion of SDS where carers and service providers are encouraged to think "outside the box" regarding carer outcomes which may also impact and facilitate safer communities;
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A specific action relates to engaging with different services who engage with all carers, irrespective of their cultural background, encouraging dialogue within cultural minorities and potentially highlighting any community safety concerns or issues.

Justification:

Through increased communication and joint working between carers, the strategy group (of which carers and their representatives are invited members) community safety issues can be discussed to enable carers to feel safe in their communities and encouragement to be more involved in their communities as needed.

3.3 Engagement

The initiative will seek to adequately engage with all members of the community in the decision-making process for the area through using VOiCE?

Yes – largely true, but still more to do

Mitigation:

Not currently within the strategy action plan although could be further discussed at the Carer Strategic Group as needed.

Justification:

Although VOiCE has not been considered in the past when consulting with carers this is an area which could be considered for future engagement activities with carers.

3.4 Identity and Citizenship

The initiative will help support and enhance the local identity whilst promoting citizenship?

Mitigation:

Encouraging carer involvement on the Carer Strategic Group;

Encouraging carers and their representatives to engage with this strategy and action plan.

Justification:

The strategy aims to support carers to remain in their caring role while also accessing their local services and supports in their locality areas. Carers are also encouraged within the strategy aims and action plan, to be involved in shaping and improving services in their localities, for the cared for person and for themselves as carers.

3.5 Social Inclusion

The initiative will promote social inclusion for all?



Yes – completely true

Mitigation:

Continue the successful joint working relationships already established through the previous carer stategies;

Increase opportunities for locality planing under the Integration Scheme of Health and Social Care;

Provide increased opportunities through the proposed carers HUB and additional support workers to provide accurate and up to date information, support and advice to carers which, in turn, may contribute to reduced inequalities e.g. benefit advice, housing support, etc to which they may be entitled.

Justification:

Through joint working with all partners to provide opportunities for carers to be supported in shaping and improving services which includes highlighting gaps in what may be required for them to maintain their caring role, the strategy and action plan encourages carer involvement which, in turn, promotes social inclusion in their communities.


The initiative will encourage the prevention, reduction, re-use, recovery or recycling of waste?

Additionally, as previously mentioned, specific actions to encourage and promote carer invovlement on strategic groups to facilitate change and improvments needed in local communities, relevant to the needs of carers. This may, inadvertently, also support the communities cultural and recreational needs also.

Justification:

Various strategy actions relate to joint working with services and service providers in local communities. Carers have the opportunity to encourage new initiatives which may benefit themselves as carers, and also for the cared for person, under promotion of and utilisation of SDS.


Justification:

The strategy and action plan is for all adult carers residing in Perth and Kinross, and is inclusive of everyone.

Mitigation:

As mentioned, all young carers, under 18 years of age, are supported in the Joint Strategy for Young Carers which is managed by PKAVS and made reference to within the strategy;

Specific actions for young carers in transition from young adult carers to adult carers are outlined in the action plan.

7.1 Age

Yes – completely true

Mitigation:

Reference to all young adult carers under the age of 18 years is to the Joint Strategy for Young Carers.

Justification:

The carer strategy is for all adult carers aged 18 years and over. Actions within the strategy also support those carers who are in transition from being a young carer (under 18 years) to being an adult carer (over 18 years). All young carers are supported by the Joint Strategy for Young Carers (and made reference to in the strategy), which is currently managed by PKAVS and is being updated.

Mitigation:

All actions within the strategy relate to all carers.

Justification:

The strategy and related action plan is for all adult carers who reside in Perth and Kinross, irrespective of a disability.

Yes - completely true


Justification:




Justification:

The strategy supports the implementation of a carers HUB to provide carers with up to date and accurate information regarding all aspects of their caring role including housing, benefits, SDS and supports available. This, in turn, will promote carer empowerment to continue their caring role and reduce the stress incurred by caring and encourage a life outside of caring. This will all impact on a carers social environment, whether that be their work or home environment.

The strategy encourages adult and young adult carers in transition to access supports and services particular to their needs, which will also promote a life outside of caring.

The strategy encourages the promotion of SDS which will enable carers choice and control over services and supports individual to their needs and within their own local communities which could take the form of community learning and development opportunities.
