Travelling independently can make you feel confident.

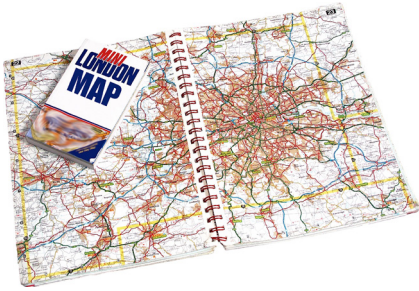


You will meet more people and go to more places you want to.

We can show you how to get on and off the bus.



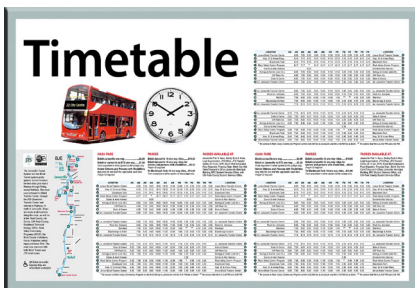
Learn how to travel on a train.
