# PROPOSED TIMETABLE OF MEETINGS 2016 AND INDICATIVE TIMETABLE 2017

## **Report by Head of Democratic Services**

## **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

This report provides an update on the operation of the 2015 Committee cycle and seeks approval of a timetable for meetings for 2016 and indicative timetable for 2017.

## 1. BACKGROUND / MAIN ISSUES

- 1.1 Since 2007, the Council has successfully operated an eight weekly cycle of committee meetings. In addition to this, the Development Management Committee operates on a four weekly basis, the Licensing Committee on a six weekly basis, and the Local Review Body meets approximately every four weeks. Timetables have also continued to take account of fixed recess periods at Easter, summer and October holiday periods.
- 1.2 The 2015 timetable has continued to work well and helped facilitate to timetable an increasing number of other meeting commitments for elected members and officers.
- 1.3 In previous years, it has been normal practice to submit a report to Council in October putting forward a proposed timetable of meetings for the following year. However, as part of the overall Perth Office Programme with Council and Committee meetings currently taking place at the Dewars Centre in Perth, this report is submitted in July 2015 to enable preparations and forward planning to begin over the summer recess period.

## 2. PROPOSED TIMETABLE

- 2.1 In continuing similar practice to previous years, the first meeting of the Housing and Health Committee has been timetabled to take place on 27 January 2016 to enable consideration of any proposed rent changes. A special meeting of the Council for setting the budget has been included provisionally for 11 February 2016.
- 2.2 Some amendments have been made to the 2016 timetable that was indicatively presented to Council in October 2014. As part of reporting arrangements for the Business Management and Improvement Plan process, it is proposed that the meetings of the Community Safety committee take place nearer the end of the committee cycle. As a result of this, there have been some amendments to the timings of the meetings of both the Audit Committee and the Executive Sub-Committee (Inspections) of the Lifelong Learning Committee.

It is also proposed that due to the timing of the celebrations taking place in Aschaffenburg to mark the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the twinning between Perth and Aschaffenburg between 25 and 28 June 2016 and the Provost's attendance at the celebrations, the Council meeting before the summer recess takes place on 22 June 2016. In line with the revised timetable for 2015, it is proposed that the Council meeting in May be scheduled to take place on 18 May 2016 following the Scottish Parliament Elections on 5 May 2016.

The indicative timetable for 2017 up until the Scottish Local Government Elections on 4 May 2017 follows a similar pattern to the proposed 2016 timetable and includes an indicative date of 17 May 2017 for the Council Statutory meeting following the elections.
