### 2015/16 FINANCIAL STATEMENT

### Joint Report by Head of Finance & Executive Director (Environment)

### PURPOSE OF REPORT

This report provides an update on 2014/15 Income and Expenditure, and details of the Income and Expenditure to 31 May 2015 and the projected outturn to 31 March 2016 for the Perth Common Good Fund.

### 1. BACKGROUND / MAIN ISSUES

1.1 The Committee approved the Perth Common Good Fund budget at the meeting of 13 May 2015. This report provides an update on the final outturn for 2014/15, and the monitoring position and projected outturn for the Financial Year 2015/16.

### 2. PROPOSALS

2.1 Financial Statement 2014/15

Report 15/187 considered by Committee on 13 May 2015 included year-end projections for Income and Expenditure to 31 March 2015. Following closure of the 2014/15 accounts, which are subject to audit by Audit Scotland, the outturn has moved favourably by £5,802 and has resulted in a deficit for the year of £24,127 and a Revenue Account Balance of £1,367,831 at 31 March 2015. The movement is mainly due to less than expected expenditure on works at Moncreiffe Island causeway and reduced depreciation charges, and an increase in income from Interest on Investments.

2.2 <u>Financial Statement 2015/16</u>

On the basis of Appendix 1, which includes the revised Revenue Account Balance noted in Section 2.1, it is anticipated that there will be deficit of  $\pm 104,400$  in 2015/16 and that the Fund's estimated Revenue Account Balance will be  $\pm 1,263,431$  at 31 March 2016.

### 2.2.1 Repairs and Maintenance

The demolition of the Harbour End Store was considered and approved by Committee on 13 May 2015. The estimated cost of demolition at that time was included within the budget for 2015/16, however a further report will be considered by Committee at this meeting. The revision to the previous estimate results in a £9,000 increase in the cost of works and this has been included within the expenditure projections to 31 March 2016.

# 2.3 Perth City Hall

- 2.3.1 A report providing an update on the marketing of Perth City Hall, including analysis of offers received, will be considered by the Council on 1 July 2015. The report includes confirmation that Perth City Hall forms part of the common good of the former Burgh of Perth. Report 12/433 presented to Committee on 3 October 2012 provided an overview of the accounting treatment for common good properties. In summary when a property forming part of the common good is no longer used by the Council for the provision of services and is therefore surplus, the risks and rewards of ownership accrue to the common good and the associated income and expenditure will accrue to the Common Good Fund.
- 2.3.2 The accounting policy for common good properties includes provision that there will be no retrospective adjustments for income and expenditure incurred during the period prior to confirmation that a property should be regarded as forming part of the common good. Following confirmation that Perth City Hall forms part of the common good, the income and expenditure arising from maintaining the hall, or from disposal of the hall, or from alternative non Council use of the hall, will accrue to Perth Common Good fund with effect from 1 April 2015.
- 2.3.3 Following the review of the property costs incurred during the five years 2010/11 to 2014/15, it is anticipated that repairs and maintenance costs for Perth City Hall can be contained within the core Repairs and Maintenance budget for Perth Common Good Fund.

# 3. CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 The Committee is requested to note the unaudited Perth Common Good Fund Income and Expenditure outturn for the year ended 31 March 2015, the Income and Expenditure to 31 May 2015 and the projected outturn to 31 March 2016.
- 3.2 The Committee is requested to note the potential financial implications arising from confirmation that Perth City Hall forms part of the common good.
