#### Resolved:

- (i) The response to Dundee City Council's Proposal Paper as detailed in Appendix 2 to Report 15/104 be approved, subject to a revision to the final sentence of paragraph 1 as follows: However, the response from Perth and Kinross Council focuses solely on the impact of these proposals on Perth and Kinross pupils who are already attending Menzieshill High School, and those primary pupils living in Perth and Kinross who are resident in the catchment areas and attend associated primary schools and who may be affected in the future.
- (ii) The Executive Director (Education and Children's Services) be instructed to submit the revised response to Dundee City Council, in accordance with the timescales outlined within the Proposal Paper.
