The Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 2013

The submission of a pre-application screening notice is optional. It is for instances where the applicant is uncertain whether their proposal falls in to one of the types of development categorised as either 'national' or 'major' under the Town and Country Planning (Hierarchy of Developments) (Scotland) Regulations 2009. The Planning Authority has 21 days to respond to the notice and advise whether the proposal requires a formal Pre-Application Notice.
