

Loch Leven Heritage Trail – an off road constructed path which is suitable and popular with all types of users. It links Kirkgate Park in Kinross with Vane Farm on the B907 around the shores of Loch Leven. The 8 mile (13km) path also connects to communities offering refreshments, toilets and points of cultural interest along the route.



Loch Leven is a National Nature Reserve due to its bird interest, and the path gives wonderful views of the loch and its wildlife. Several hides can be visited along the way.



The bridge over the River Leven cut at Findatie is a good place too look out for otters and kingfishers.



The section of path linking Findatie to Vane Farm offers great views from a higher path. There is no entry charge at Vane Farm, the café has viewing windows with binoculars provided and is well worth a look!



At Findatie there is a gentle gradient leading from the car park down to Loch Leven Heritage Trail. At Vane Farm, the path uses a subway with steps to cross the busy B9097 to the Centre.
