## EDUCATION & CHILDREN'S SERVICES

In terms of The Schools (Consultation) (Scotland) Act 2010, Perth and Kinross Council is now formally embarking upon consultations with regard to **the following proposal:**

- **Education provision at Struan Primary School be permanently discontinued with effect from 31 March 2017, or as soon as possible thereafter;**
- **That the pupils of Struan Primary School catchment area permanently receive their education at Blair Atholl Primary School, from 1 April 2017 or as soon as possible thereafter; and**
- **That the delineated area of Blair Atholl Primary School be permanently extended to subsume the whole delineated area of Struan Primary School from 1 April 2017.**

A public meeting will be held in **Blair Atholl**. **The date and venue of this meeting is published in the Proposal Paper and on the Council's website [www.pkc.gov.uk](http://www.pkc.gov.uk)** where the authority will be represented for the purposes of explaining the proposal to be considered and taking account of representations made at the meeting as part of the consultation process.
