Building Information

- The school was officially mothballed on 24 October 2016. This means the operation of the school has been suspended with pupils moved to another school
- In October 2016 when the school was mothballed, there were 3 pupils attending the school
- The maximum number of pupils that can attend the school is 50
- The school is rated “C” for condition and “B” for suitability. This means the suitability is satisfactory but the condition needs to be improved

Options

- **Consider closing school – pupils attend alternative primary school to Forgandenny Primary School**
- **Catchment area is reviewed to determine whether this would increase the school roll sufficiently to ensure the future sustainability of the school**
