Appointment of Clinical Professional Team Managers

Perth & Kinross Health & Social Care Partnership are pleased to announce the commencement of our Clinical Professional Team Managers (CPTMs) who have taken up post on the 3rd September 2018.

The introduction of our CPTMs allows us to progress the Integration agenda at locality and sub locality level.

The Locality Managers, CPTMs and Professional Leaders (Lead Nurse, Lead Allied Health Professions (AHP), Associate Nurse Director, and Director of AHPs) have identified the reporting lines for teams which are explained in this briefing

To support our CPTMs transition into their new roles, we have agreed a four week lead in period to ensure that quality, safety and continuity of care is maintained through this transition period.

The CPTM role has a dual role of professional leadership responsibility, either Nursing or AHP (40%), and operational management for Integrated Care Teams (60%).

Norma Patrick and Tia Dixon hold strategic professional leadership roles for Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy across Perth & Kinross.

Team Leaders/Senior Charge Nurses/Lead Staff for Perth and Kinross wide services should report to the CPTM detailed in this briefing. Within teams staff should continue to report to their immediate line manager. Staff with any queries should direct these to their line manager who will work together with the professional leads in the locality to secure advice and guidance.

Community Hospital Management will remain with current arrangements until 8th October 2018 under Wilma Latham and Lindsey Bailie until formal handover arrangements are made following the CPTM's annual leave.

Inpatient MFTE/Stroke Unit, Psychiatry of Old Age, Intermediate Care

The Inpatient Services Manager post is currently vacant, *Lindsey Bailie and Amanda Taylor* will provide interim management cover until the new manager has been appointed.
