

# School Estates Review Parent/Carer Focus Groups

## Progress to date

Phase 2 options appraisal consultation process has taken place on the following options:

1. **Improve condition rating of school**
2. **Improve condition rating of school and include S5 & S6 at Pitlochry High School to increase occupancy level**
3. **Improve condition rating of school and extend catchment area to increase occupancy level**
4. **S4 pupils move to Breadalbane Academy and review use of Pitlochry HS building**
5. **Close Pitlochry High School (Secondary) and pupils move to Breadalbane Academy**

## Update Report to LLC on 27 March

- ▶ Option 5, closure, was removed due to perceived community detriment
- ▶ Strong support was reported for Pitlochry High School to include S5/6. There was a view that this would benefit the pupils who currently have to travel and transition to Breadalbane
- ▶ A wider review of the delivery of senior phase education across Highland Perthshire was proposed. This will be carried out based on the principle that neither school will experience any educational detriment.
- ▶ Any catchment review will not be considered until after this review has taken place
- ▶ Models for senior phase education (S4, S5 and S6) in Highland Perthshire will be developed for consideration, staff, pupils and parents will be fully engaged in this process. It is anticipated that the outcome of this process will be reported to this Committee on 4 September 2019 or as soon as possible thereafter.

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## **Option 1: Improve condition rating of school and include S5 & S6 at Pitlochry High School to increase occupancy level**

**Sharing of information for consideration in greater depth regarding the proposal to include S5/6 at Pitlochry High School from 2 perspectives:**

- 1. What would this 'look like' and what are the implications of this for Pitlochry High School**
- 2. What would this 'look like' and what are the implications of this for Breadalbane Academy**

## **Option 2: S4 pupils move to Breadalbane Academy and review use of Pitlochry HS building**

During the previous consultation there was little support for this option primarily was viewed as 'closure by stealth' or as a diminution of the educational offer to young people who live in Pitlochry.

This option needs to be re-examined and considered further for the following reasons:

- ▶ The curriculum rationale of Curriculum for Excellence states that the BGE ends at the end of S3 and the Senior Phase begins at the beginning of S4
- ▶ Breadalbane Academy offers a wider breadth and choice of subjects in S4
- ▶ Pupils told us that there were some negative experiences in transitioning and joining senior phase at Breadalbane in S5

## **Option 3: Developing a Highland Perthshire Learning Partnership to significantly enhance the current arrangements**

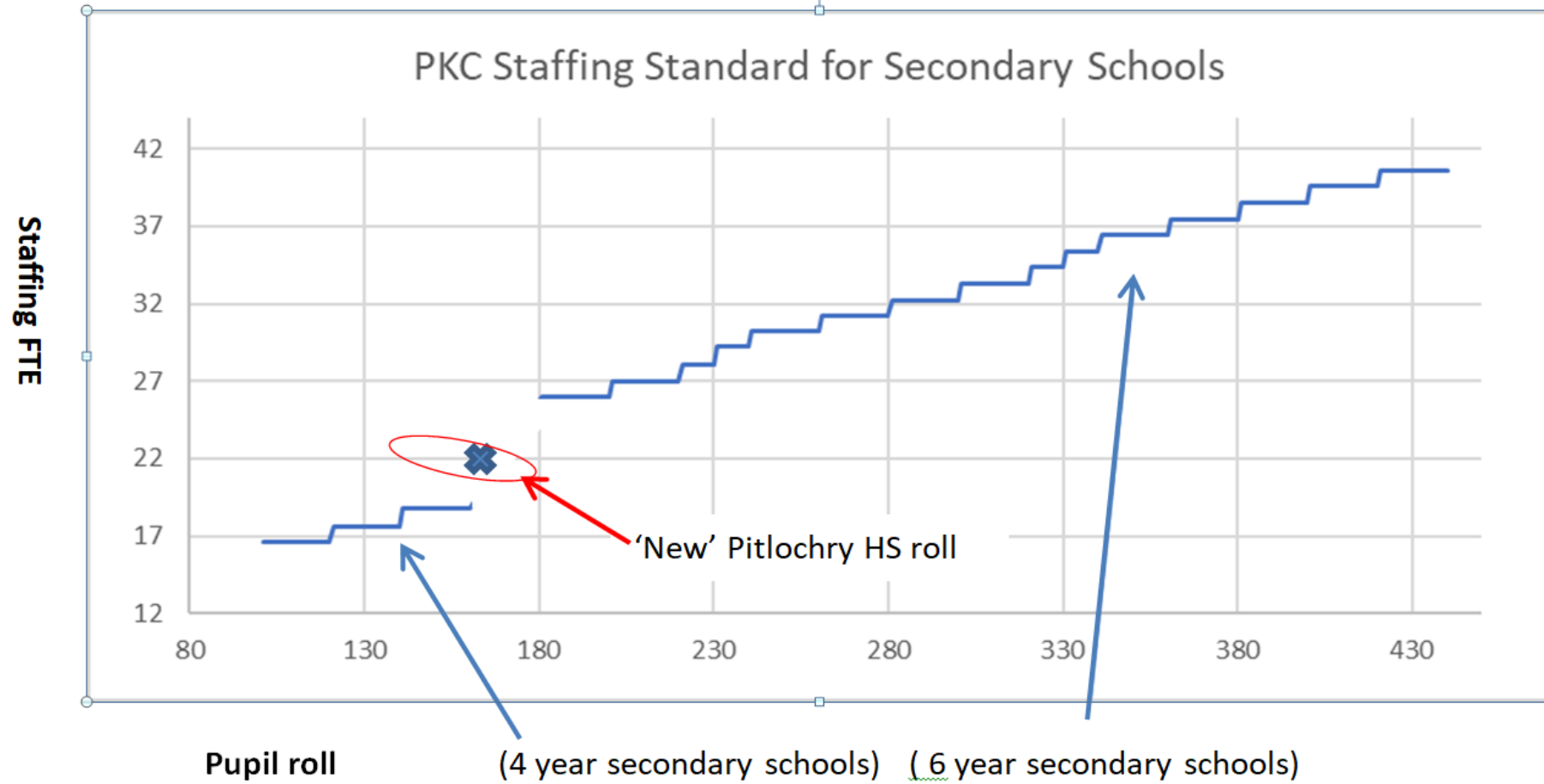
**With neither school to experience any educational detriment, exemplify what improved and enhanced transition, virtual/digital learning, working with other partners such as Perth College UHI and building stronger relationships between the schools would look like:**

- 1. Enhanced Transition, ongoing curricular collaboration and stronger relationships**
- 2. Virtual and Digital learning developments**
- 3. Expanding the Perth College offer in Highland Perthshire**
- 4. Developing the Highland Perthshire Learning Partnership**
- 5. Give consideration to how Pitlochry High School could potentially be developed further as a community hub**

## **Option 1:** **Improve condition rating of school and include S5 & S6 at Pitlochry High School to increase occupancy level**

- ▶ **What would this 'look like' and what are the implications of this for Pitlochry High School?**
- ▶ **18 pupils in current S5 20 pupils in current S6: 38 pupils**
- ▶ **turning Pitlochry HS into a 6-year secondary school, would place the school on a different staffing scale.**
- ▶ **The minimum roll of a 6 year secondary school according to the 17/18 PKC staffing standard is 181. The roll of Pitlochry High School after returning the S5/6 would be 154**
- ▶ **Please note these numbers are based on current actual roll and do not include the pupils who have transitioned to Breadalbane and subsequently left school as we have no way of qualifying the reasons for those leavers.**

## Overall change in staffing consequent upon the return of 'Pitlochry' S5/6 pupils

- ▶ Staff reduction at Breadalbane 2.2
- ▶ Staff gain at Pitlochry 7.4
- ▶ Net gain in PKC secondary staffing 5.2
- ▶ Based on current salary information this would present an annual ongoing cost increase of **between £200K and £250K p.a.**
- ▶ **Even with the addition of staffing the 'new' Pitlochry HS curricular offering would remain significantly narrower than that currently offered at Breadalbane.**

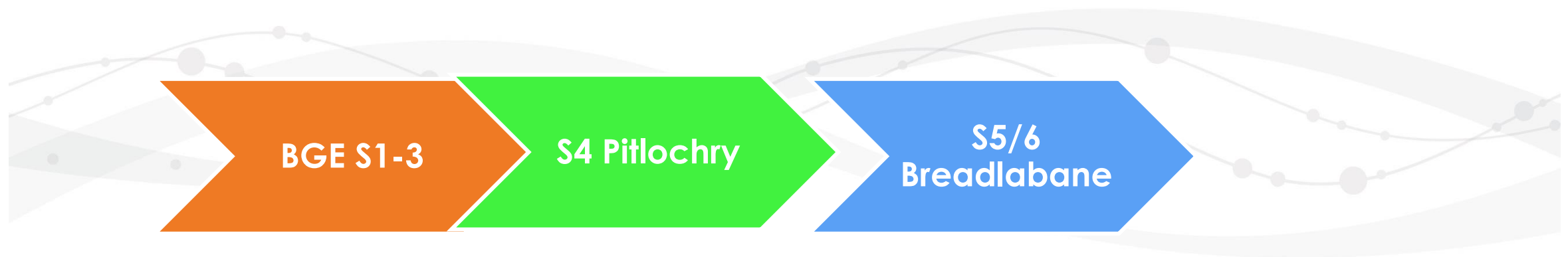

- ▶ What would this 'look like' and what are the implications of this for **Breadalbane Academy?**
- ▶ 18 pupils in current S5 20 pupils in current S6: 38 pupils
- ▶ Staff reduction implications
- ▶ Curricular impact
- ▶ 2.2FTE =53 periods of teaching time= 2 classes from each column and 1 each from Activities and PE in real terms however the impact may be wider than that given that the removal of the 2.2 teachers would also reduce course choice in whatever subjects those teachers taught.

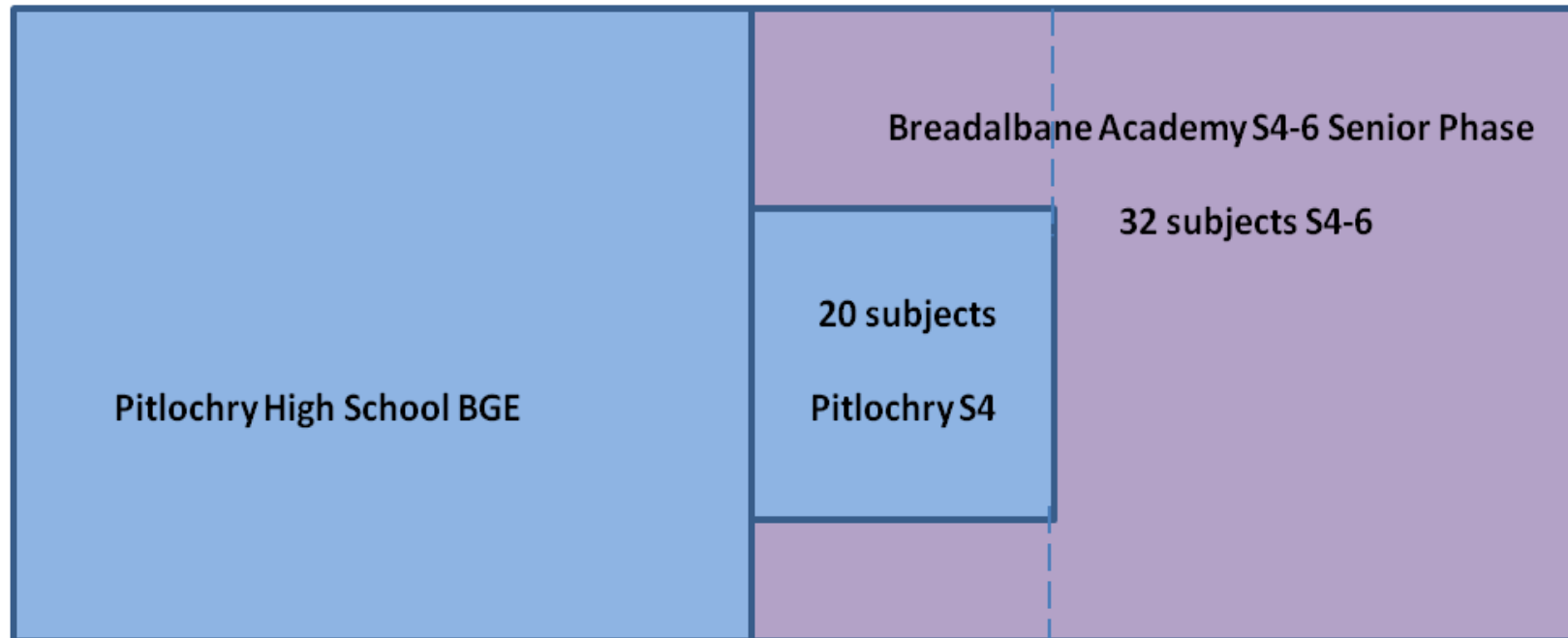
