Neighbour Issues

If you are experiencing difficulties with your neighbours, there are ways to try and help the situation. Antisocial behaviour can take many forms including noise nuisance, drunken behaviour, fly tipping, verbal abuse and drug dealing.

If you are a Council or Housing Association tenant, you should contact them in the first instance. If the other tenant is also a Council or Housing Association tenant, they should not be causing nuisance or disturbances to other residents. Anti-social behaviour can be reported to the Safer Communities Team – more information can be found on our website. If your complaint is of a more serious nature, please call the non-emergency Police Scotland number 101.

Unless Police Scotland or Safer Communities confirm that you are at risk to reside in your current home, you will not receive any priority. When completed a housing application, all crime reference numbers or evidence will be needed along with names and addresses of the perpetrators.
