imagination.



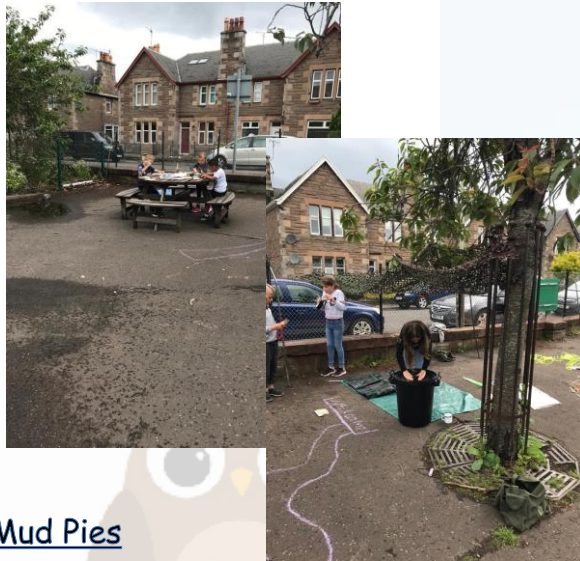

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Here are some ideas you can do at home



Mud Pies

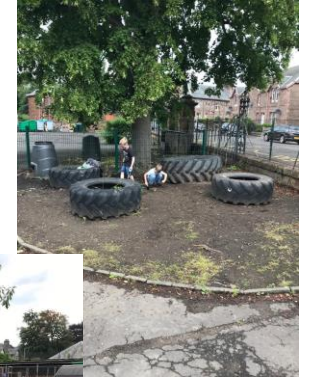
Buy some sterile soil and use old pots, pans and utensils and let the children explore the mud. Talk to the children about plants growing and mini beasts to help them learn about the world around them.

Leaf printing/rubbing

Collect some leaves and provide paint or crayons. You can paint the leaf then print or put paper over a leaf and rub the crayon over the leaf to make great patterns.

Bark Rubbing

Have fun in the garden or park. Use crayons to create great patterns. Just use the side of the crayon and rub over the paper on the tree to make great designs. If you don't have crayons try tin foil! Promotes early math skills- looking at patterns
