Help is available

I was in an abusive relationship for 18 months and one night the neighbours rang the police. The officers attended and were able to signpost me for supports available locally. The support offered to me by a community organisation allowed me to see that not only was I in a violent relationship but I was also being controlled financially, sexually and psychologically. I had lost my identity, job and friends leaving me very isolated and living in constant fear that my partner would return. With the support given I now have more confidence. feel safer and understand that none of this was my fault. I have since returned to education to create a new life for myself and my child.
