I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 9 - Almond and Earn. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.

The electorate was 7,985 and the number of ballot papers received was 4,005 giving a percentage turnout of 50.2%. There were 45 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 991.
