# Family Group Decision-Making: adults coming together to support you.



### I am an independent Family Group Decision-Making co-ordinator. It's my job to:

- listen to you;
- find out what's going well for you;
- find out what needs to change;
- help you to have a say in what's happening right now;
- help you to have a say in how you are looked after.



## l will:

arrange an advocate for you if you want to (this is someone who can speak on your behalf to share your views). This can be someone you already know;



help you choose who to involve in your family plan. That could be your mum, your dad, brothers, sisters, grandparents and anyone else who is important to you;





meet with your family and other people that are important to you to find out what everyone can do to support you;

bring everyone together in a meeting where it is safe to do so to make a family plan to support you. You get to help choose how the family will meet, where and when the meeting might be, and what refreshments we might have.

## What will happen in the meeting?

- Everyone will get a chance to hear how things are going and to ask questions.
- Your advocate can help you to share your views if you have chosen to have one.
- You and your family are left alone to have private time to make your family plan and have refreshments.
- Everyone will work together in agreeing a plan to support you.
- You will then go off and try your plan for the next few months.
- I will get in touch in 3 months to find out how things are going, or sooner if we need to.
