1. Why is this information being processed?

The information provided by you will be used by Perth & Kinross Council to inform the Rent Level Options Consultation which we are obliged to undertake under legislation.

The purpose of the survey is to influence the decision making process about the rent levels for the next financial year and the housing service tenants receive.

This feedback from tenants will allow us to improve service delivery and your neighbourhoods and properties, as well as informing our service improvements.

2. Who is processing this information?

3. Why is it lawful for the Council to process this information?

The Council is permitted to process your personal data in this way because it has an obligation to do so under the Housing (Scotland) Act 2010 and the Scottish Social Housing Charter. Landlords are obliged to submit the data in their Annual Return of the Charter (ARC) by the end of May each year. Under this legislation, landlords are required to undertake consultation with tenants at least 4 weeks in advance of an increase.

Formally, the processing of personal data provided to us for this purpose satisfies Article 6(1)(c) of the UK General Data Protection Regulation-"...processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject". 4. 5. Will this information be shared?

We will share limited personal information with our contractor (Knowledge Partnership), who are carrying out this survey on our behalf. This is in order for them to be able to contact tenants to ask if they want to agree to take part in the survey.

The information you provide will be used for research and survey purposes to help us determine the appropriate rent increase for the next financial year and improve the services we offer to you. It is important to note that Knowledge Partnership do not obtain any information from research participants without their agreement. This agreement may be asked for verbally or given in writing at the start of or during any stage of the survey

Your personal information will not be disclosed to any other third parties unless it's necessary for us to do so in order to verify its accuracy, prevent or detect crime, protect public funds or where required by law. The Council may check information provided by you, or information about you provided by a third party, with other information held by us.

6. How long will this information be kept for?

Personal information held on Perth and Kinross Council systems in relation to the tenant satisfaction pulse survey will be held on the Knowledge Partnership system for a 2-month period after the research is completed. The duration of this period will be communicated to the participants as part of the research. After this it will be deleted.
