We are delighted to tell everyone that we successfully passed the SNSIAP audit on 15th August 2022 at Type III accreditation for Welfare Benefits, this means that we have retained accreditation to represent clients at courts and tribunals in respect of welfare benefits ©

BENEFIT GAINS

For the period July to September 2022 we were able to verify £781,728.41 in benefit gains, that's all *additional income* for the people of Perth and Kinross.

MACMILLAN SERVICE

Our <u>enhanced welfare rights service to people affected by cancer,</u> their family and their carers. Over £175,565 of our benefit gains went

to households affected by cancer. We met with our **Health colleagues** at the Cornhill Unit, Perth Royal Infirmary to promote the service.

CONTACTS/REFERRALS

From June – September 2022 we received **1711 contacts**. This is a **26% increase** on the number of contacts we received for the same period last year and a **13% increase** in contacts compared with the first quarter of the year.

People are increasingly using online methods to access our service and we want to encourage this trend as much as possible. It maximises access to the service at can be done at any time of the day or night.

A massive **939 referrals** were made to us using **our online methods**, that's **57%** of the overall contacts we received.

Last year (2021/22) over the same period only **47% of contacts were** made online.

Our plea to workers is to use our <u>online form</u> to refer, so that we can make the best use of our resources and free up our telephone advice line for people with no digital access.

The majority of the households that contact us live in **Perth City Centre (21%), Perth City North (21%) and Strathmore (10%) wards**.

Followed by Almond & Earn (7%), Strathearn (7%) and Blairgowrie & The Glens (7%) and finally, Highland (6%), Kinross (6%), Perth City South (6%), Strathallan (6%), Strathtay (5%) and The Carse (5%).

APPEALS REPRESENTATION

Our appeals success rate for the second quarter was 62%.

FINANCIAL INSECURITY FUND

We received 508 applications and have spent £42,000.00 this quarter.



WELFARE TRUST

We received **98 applications** and processed **74** this quarter.

WORKING WITH PARTNERS
