Duty 3: Additional Improve communication with pupils with disability along with communicating to them information that is provided in writing for pupils who are not disabled, in appropriate alternative formats and taking account of any preferences expressed by them and their parents. Specialised items of hardware and software, such as alternative keyboard, mouse or switches can be easily installed and used Accessed and installed	
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Software needed by learners with disabilities, such as speech output or screen magnification, can be installed and used	
Screen Readers such as NVDA, JAWS ¹ or Seeing AI can be installed and used by a learner with visual impairment	
Speech recognition software for dyslexic learners can be installed, however Office 365 Dictate will be available on all PKC laptops.	
Software to support planning and organising e.g. <i>Inspiration</i> , can be installed and used	
Software that uses additional resources, such as <i>Clicker 8</i> or <i>Boardmaker</i> symbols can be installed correctly but only where specifically purchased by the school or agreed by the AT Panel
