Contactless payments are available at Blackwatch Gardens, Foundry Lane, King Street, Kinnoull Street, Princes Street, Scott Street, South Street and in Canal Street car park, Charles Street car park, Scott Street car park, South Inch car park, Speygate car park and Thimblerow car park. Chip and pin payments are also available at Canal Street Multi-Storey.

Blue Badge holders are allowed to park in any disabled bay or Pay & Display bay on-street or in a Council car park free of charge and without time limit. Visitors with badges from outside the UK should contact Parking Services to register their badge. Badges are only valid if they are in date and being used for the benefit of the badge holder.

Motorcycle Parking

Motorcycles can park free of charge in any on or off street Council Pay & Display bay. Dedicated motorcycle bays can be found in Canal Street Multi-Storey, Scott Street car park and on Scott Street.

Park & Ride in Perth City

There are two Park & Ride sites operating in Perth - one at Broxden and the other at Scone providing convenient parking next to the departure points for buses into the city centre and express coaches serving other Scottish cities.

Parking in Perth City

Parking in Perth City is divided up into three zones.

Zone 1

Zone 1 encompasses all Council on and off-street parking bordered by Mill Street, South Methven Street, Canal Street and Tay Street (north of Queen's Bridge).

On-street parking is limited to 1 hour at a flat rate of \pounds 1.70 per house and off-street parking is limited to 1 hour at a flat rate of \pounds 1.50

Parking for up to 4 hours at a flat rate of £1.50 pe hour is available at the Scott Street Car Park. All day parking is available at the Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park at a flatrate of £1.50 per hour fo the first 2 hours, then up to 3 hours at £4.60, 4 hours at £6.00, 6 hours at £9.20 and up to 10 hours at £12.30. Season Tickets are available for Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park.

Zone 2

Zone 2 is bor dered by Tay Street (south of Queen's Bridge), Marshall Place, Caledonian Road, Atholl Street and includes the Back Wynd Car Park in Bridgend.

Parking is for a maximum of 4 hours at a flat rate of \pounds 1.70 per hour on-street or \pounds 1.50 per hour off-street .

Zone 3


Zone 3 encompasses the South Inch car park and the on-street parking on Shore Road, Edinburgh Road, St Leonard's Bank, the east bank of the Tay with the Norrie Miller and Riverside Turning Head car parks.

Parking on-street is for a maximum of 10 hours and costs \pounds 1.10 for 1 hour, \pounds 1.70 for 2 hours, \pounds 2.60 for 3 hours, \pounds 3.30 for 4 hours, \pounds 5.00 for 6 hours and \pounds 6.70 for 10 hours.

Parking off-street is for a maximum of 10 hours and costs \pounds 1.00 for 1 hour, \pounds 1.50 for 2 hours, \pounds 2.40 for 3 hours, \pounds 3.00 for 4 hours, \pounds 4.60 for 6 hours and \pounds 6.00 for 10 hours.
