



Survey Questions - based on 19 responses

Is your voice (views and opinions) heard and taken seriously in champs?	17 young people said said they feel heard and taken seriously at champs
Do you feel valued and respected in champs?	15 young people said they feel valued and respected.
Do you feel a sense of belonging in champs?	14 young people said they feel a sense of belonging and care in champs.
Has attending champs helped with your experience of school?	16 young people said that attending champs has improved their experience of school
Have you developed new and meaningful relationships with staff and peers since coming to champs?	17 young people said that Champs has helped them to develop meaningful relationships.

"I have made new friends"


What young people ask for


What you ask for	What we are doing
We would like FYI Jnr to be split by year group (S1-S3 and S4-S6)	Starting from September 2025 we will run 2 community groups one for S1-S3 and one for S4-S6
We would like more opportunities for day trips	Over the summer young services offered a variety of activities including rock climbing and canoeing. We have further events planned for young people in October and December.
We would like the language professionals use to be more youth friendly	We are doing work around child-centred case recording to ensure when professional write about young people, it is in a language they understand.
We would like support to learn life skills	FYI Jnr and Seniors will be looking at doing targeted working around life skills i.e. budgeting, online safety, cooking and more.
We would like more social work visits	We are now making plans for newly qualified social workers to become involved in champs.
